Discover the DR

The Dominican Republic is a country of wonders. If you have a few days rent a car, mark a few points on your map and enjoy the best the DR has to offer. The following are recommendations for some of the best sights and attractions outside of Santo Domingo.

Southwest

Among the Southwest's best attractions are the Lago Enriquillo, Bahía de las Águilas, Cabo Rojo and the Polo Magnético. Must sees also include the Salt Mines, the Larimar Mines and the Hoyo de Pelempito (Park).

East & Southeast

Enjoy the wonders of the eastern and southeastern part of the DR by visiting Isla Saona, Isla Catalina or the Cuevas de las Maravillas. Take in the sights of Altos de Chavón, the waters of Playa Esmeralda or golf at Punta Espada or Teeth of the Dog.

Central

The Central part of the DR has its wonders, including the towns of Constanza, Jarabacoa and Santiago where you should see the Centro Cultural Leonel Jiménez. Enjoy the Pico Duarte, if you can, as well as the Salto de Jimenoa and Aguas Blancas (falls).

Northeast & Samana

Samaná is an escape of natural beauty. Los Haitises, Playa Rincón or the Salto de Limón should be on the top of your list. Cayo Levantado is worth a trip and whale watching is a seasonal event you'll be sure to remember.

North & Northwest

The Northern part of the DR has the country's best wind and water sports. Enjoy the hidden treasure that is Punta Rucia or take up a few rounds of golf at Playa Dorada or Playa Grande. Mount Isabela de Torres is a great day adventure, as are the Damajagua falls, while Ocean World's Bravissimo is a must see.
